



Summary Fees 2024-25

Registration Fee

If you would like to register your child for a place at Brighton College, we ask for a registration fee of £180* for our UK pupils. The registration fee is non-refundable.

Acceptance Deposit

Once offered, a place cannot be secured until the College is in receipt of the completed and signed Acceptance Form and cleared deposit.

A deposit is required on joining the College and a top-up element may be required if you switch between Day and Boarding Status.

* At the time of publication (June 2024) VAT was not chargeable on these fees, and all figures quoted are exclusive of VAT. As from 1st January 2025, VAT is now payable and must be added to the quoted fee prices.

Please note that for Full Boarding, two terms' fees will be immediately payable if, for any reason, the acceptance of a place is cancelled less than two terms before entry or if the pupil does not join the College after a place has been accepted. For Weekly Boarding and Day places, one term's notice is required, and if not received then the higher of one term's fees or the Acceptance Deposit becomes due and immediately payable (if not already paid) and will be retained by the College.

Once accepted, deposits are retained and held over from term to term until the pupil leaves the most senior of the schools they attend. Any balance due will be refunded as a credit (without interest) against the final payment of extras or other sums due to the College. Please note, deposits are not a contribution towards the first, final or any term's tuition or boarding fees.

For pupils entering the Senior School, the deposit will only be refunded if a pupil does not meet the requirements set out within their offer letter.

Administration Fee

A non-refundable charge of £90* is made to cover the immediate administrative costs of entry into the College. This is added to the first term's fee.

Termly Tuition Fees - UK Pupils

Fees are due and payable before 8am on the first day of term. For full details please refer to the Standard Terms and Conditions.

* At the time of publication (June 2024) VAT was not chargeable on these fees, and all figures quoted are exclusive of VAT. As from 1st January 2025, VAT is now payable and must be added to the quoted fee prices, although the College is making transitional price support for the current academic year available to payers whose tuition/boarding fees are subject to VAT. The combined effect of the College's price support and the imposition of VAT means that parents will see a 10% increase for the remainder of the academic year from January 2025 for tuition/boarding fees. Please note that it is not always possible to change from a Full Boarding to a Weekly Boarding (or Day) place. Requests should be made with a minimum of two terms' notice to the Director of Boarding and the Director of Admissions. In some cases we may need to charge the relevant prior Boarding fee for the whole academic year if a mid-year switch is requested.

Additional Support Fees

There is a range of other support offered for pupils at the College, details of which can be found in our Detailed Fees Structure document. These include specialist learning support, English as an Additional Language (EAL), music, drama (LAMDA) and dance lessons and optional insurances.
